In her previous work, she was in charge of a number of supervisory and regulatory areas in the financial sector, including pension and investment funds, providing investment services and performing investment activities, and the crypto asset market. She participated in a number of legislative and regulatory projects. She is a member of several boards of the European Supervisory Authority for Securities and Capital Markets (ESMA). She graduated in mathematics at the Faculty of Science, majoring in Financial and Business Mathematics, and holds a Certificate in Quantitative Finance (CQF).
